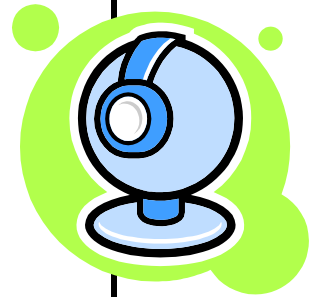

CYBER BULLYING

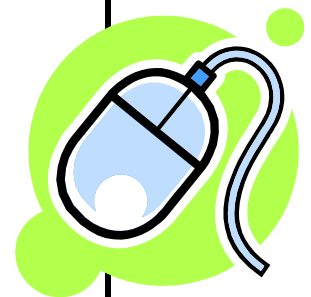
Wednesday, February 8
